SCHEDULE

Doors Open at 8:00 am. Primary, Beginner and Novice registration **8:30 am. Dancing starts at 9:00am** with the Primary 16 Pas de Basques. Primary dancers will complete all their dances before Beginner and Novice dancing, which will **start at 9:15** am with the Fa-la-la-la Trophy Fling. Primary awards to follow the Fa-la-la-la Fling.

Demonstration event will be following completion of the morning dancing.

Highland Ornament Exchange after morning awards: We would like to extend an invitation to dancers to take part in a highland ornament exchange during noon hour. If you bring an ornament, you will receive one. <u>There is no obligation to take part.</u>

Intermediate and Premier registration **12:30pm**. Dancing will start at **approximately 1pm** with the Fling, after ornament exchange. **First and Second place Premier dancers in the Jig will dance off** for the James Irving Smith Memorial Trophy.

Entries must be received by November 24, 2024. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organizer with a \$10 late fee charged. No refunds will be given. For category changes, please email gmsadance@gmail.com

Age as of December 7, 2024. Age categories will be determined by number of entries. First to enter, last to dance. Awards will be withheld without a current RSOBHD dancer registration card (presented at registration) and a \$5 penalty charged to cover postage.

Prizes: Medals will be awarded in all categories, with the exception of **cash prizes in the oldest Premier class.** Trophies will be awarded in all categories except Primary.

Judging: Dancers will be judged according to the techniques of the RSOBHD. Judge's decision shall be final. There will be no access to the judge's score sheets. In the event of a protest, a \$35.00 non-refundable fee must accompany a written complaint and be submitted to the organizers the same day as the competition.

The Greater Moncton Scottish Association will not be responsible for any injuries, accidents or lost articles to competitors or spectators.

Demonstration Event

This is open to any new dancers who are not competing but would like the experience of performing on stage. The event will not be adjudicated. Dancers will receive a participation ribbon.

Dancers 6 years and under can register for 16 Pas de Basques and Pas de Basques and High Cuts, and those 7 years and older a 4 step Highland Fling. Dancers can perform in a white shirt/blouse, white knee socks, ghillies and a kiltie. Your dance teacher should be able to help with costuming.

We would like dancers to be at the venue for **11am**. Dancers will perform following completion of the morning dancing and prior to awards. **Please use the Zeffy link above to register your dancer.**
